Before worship

Take the **helmet of salvation** and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Ephesians 6:17

Helmets are everywhere! Skateboarders, bike and motor bike riders, sports people, workers on building sites, climbers and rescue people all wear them. A large array of activities involve danger that leave heads vulnerable to injury so in some situations we are even required by law to wear helmets.

And children are required to wear them too when they are engaged in some of these activities.

But how often do children choose to wear them? They would much rather play without having to wear their helmets. Often they'll forget or make excuses because they don't see the danger.

Good parents want to save their children from unnecessary injuries so they provide helmets, and then will cajole, remind, insist - do what ever they need to do to see their child's head protected.

It seems to me that God acts exactly as the good parent. He provides a helmet for our protection, and through the church family, the Spirit and the Word, He encourages us to wear it.

Our problem too often is that we don't see danger and so we neglect to wear His helmet. Perhaps we need to trust God's wisdom a little more because The Creator of Life knows more than we can ever understand and He knows we are under spiritual attack even when we do not recognise it ourselves.

Satan plays deadly contact sports with us, leads us on dangerous escapades away from truth and would have us there without any protection at all. God knows and understands Satan's tricks and so He gives us this Helmet of Salvation. And it will save us from all the harm and deceit of the evil one for it is His perfect Salvation

Thank You dear Lord for the peace and protection You provide. Help us to gladly wear the helmet of Salvation and to trust it's strength. Amen.
