#### **Before worship**

Freedom is something we in Australia often take for granted. On Remembrance Day and Anzac Day our nation pauses to reflect on what our freedom has cost in terms of human life, scarred and sacrificed in war. Lest we forget.

Everything we have on earth has a price tag but freedom costs more than most. Yet even this, which is worth dying for, may only be a temporary blessing. Therefore, it is wise to remember the One who died to secure eternal freedom.

If the human sacrifice of war has historical benefits for us, how much more so the sacrifice of Christ who died, once and for all, - for all people, for all time. The Book of Hebrews tells us that Christ died to remove sin by His own sacrifice and when He comes again, it will not be to deal with sin, but to bring salvation to all who are eagerly waiting for Him. And that salvation involves <u>eternal</u> freedom.

Our lost soldiers are justified in Christ along with us and though they gave their earthly lives, Christ has offered His that they may have eternal life. 
