End Times

Jesus said to them: "Watch out that no one deceives you. Many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am he,' and will deceive many". Mark 13:5-6

It is difficult to talk about the return of Jesus and the end of the world as we know it. While the bible speaks plainly about this reality, false teachers have terrified and spiritually oppressed people with their declarations of imminent catastrophe. In the late 1970s a psychotic cult leader named Jim Jones was responsible for holding hundreds of people against their will in a compound in Guyana, murdered a U.S. congressman and forced almost 1,000 people to commit suicide. Jones claimed he spoke for God. Any quick google search of end-times cult will show hundreds of groups who have believed with certainty that the world was about to end and they had the only way of salvation.

The problem is that these leaders used passages from the bible to point to themselves rather than Jesus. When Jesus talks about the time when he will reappear, he does it with an invitation to believe in him and trust in his actions and love. Cults, and even some Christian denominations, that point to a leader, a date, a practice, anything other than the love and grace of Jesus are distorting his message and trying to control good-hearted, faithful people. Getting involved with such organisations is spiritually harmful.

Jesus always asks us to focus on him. God's Holy Spirit quickens our spirit to acknowledge Jesus as Lord and God. The entire bible is a testament to Jesus' love for us, his revelation in human form and his sacrifice for our sin. He does not want to frighten or control us. Jesus wants us to genuinely love him and trust his character. When we hear of trouble, we are not shaken, rather we look to him who gives us certainty.

Day Connect Group





Sunday 25th November

Cynthia Harbison, who is the Pastoral Care Worker (formerly called chaplains or Christian Pastoral Support Workers) at Wynn Vale Primary School, will be speaking at our Sunday morning service on 25 November.

PCWs promote social, emotional and spiritual wellbeing through role modelling, mentoring, pastoral care and structured programs for primary and secondary school students and staff in public schools.

PCWs are funded for approximately 8 hours per week by government, and in our local area additional hours are provided by support from local churches through the Schools Ministry Group of Tea Tree Gully (SMTTG).

In broad statistical terms, for every extra hour, PCWs can support an extra 2 students.

GGLC supports the work of SMTTG through a voluntary offering.

On Sunday 25 November, envelopes will be provided if you wish to make a donation.

Envelopes can be placed in the offering plate on 25 Nov or any time thereafter

We would also like to share brunch following the service and kindly ask if you could please bring a plate of food to share.
