Advent Hope

Today is the first Sunday in Advent; a time when we prepare for the celebration of Jesus' birth. The idea of God becoming human for our sake is so amazing and incredible that we spend a few weeks contemplating this world-changing event. Each week we look at different aspects of what Jesus' incarnation means, so we will look at the hope, peace, joy and love that are part of God's plan for us.

In today's reading, Mary is told that she will miraculously become pregnant with the Son of God. From her human perspective, this is not good news. It would be normal to lose hope in the face of public disgrace and a life on the fringes of the community. After all, who is going to believe the silly tales of a teenager about visiting angels and in immaculate conception?

Mary's response was full of faith and hope in God. 'May your word be fulfilled' is her only prayer. She understands that it is the will of God that provides assurance and hope. Without God's intervention her situation is hopeless; with his intervention she will be remembered as the most famous woman of all time. The word of God and his will brings hope.

We celebrate that Jesus is the hope of the world. We celebrate that the will of God would be done and that his intervention would see his kingdom of peace, love and grace grow.


