

Advent Peace

And he will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6

Who doesn't need a bit more peace in their lives? Peace can be elusive. In fact, I hear many times people express the desire for a little bit more peace of mind. It seems that we can all suffer from a lack of peace of mind when we worry too much, we find ourselves grieving a significant loss or we are disappointed with ourselves. These are just the things that affect everyone at some point; there will be other things that rob us of our peace that are unique to us.

Our God is well aware of our need for peace. The purpose of Jesus' birth, life, death and resurrection was to bring peace between us and God and therefore peace within ourselves and in our relationships. In Advent, as we prepare for the Christmas celebration, we acknowledge that Jesus is the Prince of Peace and his arrival means that peace is available for all who put their faith in him.

When we marvel at God becoming human and we realise that he wants to be involved in our everyday life we get a new perspective on our own situations. We can trust that Mighty God will be with us, particularly in the stressful times. He calls on us to cast our worries upon him. He promises to be at work in our grief, healing and restoring. And he encourages us to look at him rather than ourselves. As we approach Christmas may we live under the reign of the Prince of Peace.


