Before worship

I remember my mother saying, "Start how you mean to finish!" Good advice for most situations and I have to admit I regret not following it sometimes.

In our ordinary, everyday lives, it is easy to think there will be time later to decide on 'things'. Really though, it is not the choices we make tomorrow that are important, it's the ones we make today because these determine our tomorrows, they determine the tomorrows of our descendants.

"Oh that you would choose life, that you and your descendants might live," was Joshua's heartfelt cry to the people of God, a people who were on the brink of embarking on a new life in the Promised Land. They were going in with high expectations but the reality of those expectations depended on their choices now. Choosing to love and follow God would lead to blessings and life.


Where: Corner of Sunnybrook Drive and Richardson Drive, Wynn Vale
