Before worship

In Matt II there were those who were derogatory of Jesus and John the Baptist because the two seemed to dance to a tune different from their own. Jesus describes them as children in the market place playing power games and sulking because their victims didn't join in. They were disgruntled at John for fasting and not taking part in their revelling and they hated that Jesus felt free to attend parties and celebrate with people from all walks of life, especially those they found unsavoury. Following a tune of restrictive laws themselves, their wisdom saw John and Jesus as threats to the security they had in their 'superior' knowledge and they did not want it threatened!

Jesus revealed that His dance steps and actions did not conform to the world or other people's expectations but were arranged according to the wisdom of God Himself and moreover He described it as wisdom freely available to everyone who would receive it like a child. It was not available to those who already knew the answers or who were convinced of their own righteousness.

Challenging people to look at the results of wisdom choices, Jesus declared, "Wisdom is proved right by her deeds." He allowed the wisdom of God to lead Him to the cross where He singlehandedly fulfilled the law of love and in this way provided salvation for all through forgiveness of sins. That same wisdom invites us to take His yoke upon ourselves, to dance to its tune and there find the way of rest, peace and comfort we so earnestly crave.

Loving Lord, You did not live with concern for Yourself but in love of others. That is the tune You offer to share with us. Help us to be child enough to accept and be guided by Your proven wisdom. In Jesus Name, Amen.



The greatest blow to the Australian Lutheran Church in World War I was the closure of its SA schools. Some were re-established within a decade, and today the sector flourishes. But what became of the 50 teachers who lost their positions on 30 June 1917?
