Before worship

Jesus the transformer

*"We have here only five loaves of bread and two fish," they answered.
"Bring them here to me," he said. And he directed the people to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the people. They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over. The number of those who ate was about five thousand men, besides women and children. Matthew 14:17-21*

Our children always enjoyed the transformers cartoon series which then became a series of movies. It was interesting to watch the lead characters change, adapt and increase when they needed to. It was also fun to watch the reaction of those around the transformers; they were almost always surprised at what they just witnessed. We would be too because we all like things to be predictable and stable. When Jesus is on the scene, however, rarely are things predictable.

Jesus takes a small amount of food, just five loaves and two fish, and transforms them into a feast for at least 5,000 people. This account is so remarkable that it is recorded in all four gospels. This story is well known, not just in Christian circles, because it tells of much more than multiplying seafood. This miracle shows us that Jesus provides for our needs. It also encourages us to be open to what Jesus can do with whatever we have. No doubt the disciples thought that the five loaves and two fish were inadequate for the situation but Jesus saw an invitation to be at work, transforming the little into abundance.

Often we think that we have little to offer. At those times Jesus points us back to the account of the feeding of the 5,000. It is in this word of God that we are encouraged to offer whatever we have to the great transformer. He will accept our gifts and multiply them beyond anything we could imagine.


