### Before worship

Some weeks one of our Readings for the Sunday will stand out with a good point for encouragement. This week all three Readings have something special that could be highlighted.

In the Old Testament with its directions regarding the Passover for the people enslaved in Egypt we read God's promise, "The blood on your doorposts will serve as a sign marking the houses where you are staying. When I see the blood I will pass over you. The plague of death will not touch you when I strike the land of Egypt." We have the story of the Exodus to show that God keeps His promises. Love in action.

In the Epistle reading, we have the favourite quote of, "Love your neighbour as yourself. Love does no wrong to others, so love fulfils the requirements of God's law." Or, as I learnt it a long time ago, 'love covers a multitude of sins.' Surely Jesus is the greatest Good Samaritan and healed by Him we are encouraged to live out His Love in our interactions with others.

And in the Gospel Jesus declares "I also tell you this: If two of you agree here on earth concerning anything you ask, my Father in heaven will do it for you. For where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them."

All three of these readings are concerned with community, with being in communion with each other and with God. We stand together under the doorposts that are marked with the blood of the lamb, as the love of the Saviour fulfils the requirements of God's law for us and He stands with us. Love is the key for living. God's love for us, our love in response, love for each other and love for Him.

Praise and thanks to You Triune God for our eternal salvation, but also for the daily, hourly, minute to minute relationship You have with us and the way You equip us to love and support others, Amen.
