#### Devotion

If you have not already I would strongly encourage you all to read the Bible readings for this week (Song of Solomon 2:8-13, James 1:17-27 and Mark 7:1-8, 14, 15, 21-23). Take time to think about what God is saying to you. I would also like to mention there is always this peace that comes over us when we read the scriptures word by word as our God is amazing. I especially feel this peace and reassurance that life is going to be okay and that God has a hope and a future for our lives which will not harm us but will prosper us (Jeremiah 29:11- My favourite Bible verse). So much happens around us that we need to hold on that God has got us and all we need to do is be still and know that He is God (Psalm 46:10).

So when we look to the readings for this week I have picked up two key points/ thoughts that I would like to share with you all.

- 1. I. From James 1: 26-27 we cannot just say we are Christians but we need to BE Christians (Through our words and actions). This may mean looking after orphans and widows in their distress (We could make this relevant to all the people in distress). As well, we need to keep ourselves from being polluted by the world (James 1: 27).
- 2. As Jesus called the crowd to him and said "listen to me, everyone, and understand this. Nothing outside a person can defile them by going into them. Rather, it is what comes out of a person that defiles them". This means that whatever comes out of a person damages them. How does this make you feel when you read this? Do you agree or disagree? Justify why you respond in that way (Maybe share your thoughts with someone else you know and will feel comfortable talking to about this).

Just a Bible verse I would like to finish with is from John 14:27....

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.
