

Before Worship

Patience in suffering: we need to learn!

Have you ever-experienced pain or suffering in your personal life? You're probably thinking: are you seriously asking this question, of course I have experienced both pain and suffering!!!

I believe many of you would agree with me that it's not a nice feeling at all to be going through! I know when I am experiencing pain I just want to get better so I can be happy again. Your pain or suffering may be from a relationship break-up, a loss of someone close to you, broken bones, a bruise (from missing the cricket ball from a bowling machine - I will learn one day to hit the ball) and the list goes on. Pain and suffering can be in a mental, physical, spiritual or emotional form. I'm personally going through a mountain in my life which I've been struggling with. When Jason asked me to write this devotion, I came across a Scripture from James 5:7-8 (NIV): "Be patient, then, brothers and sisters, until the Lord's coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop, patiently waiting for the autumn and spring rains. You too, be patient and stand firm, because the Lord's coming is near". This scripture demonstrates very clearly that we need to be patient. Just like the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop we also need to be patient and stand firm when we are in the midst of pain or suffering. It is so real that we need to just hold on, be patient and stand firm in our faith until the Lord comes again. It is so important that we seek God in those challenging times so we can let GO of it all, and let GOD heal our pain. Let God be YOUR hope, therefore do not try to fill your heart, mind and soul with things of this world but of Jesus! He is the way, the truth and the life (John 14:6). So please, feel encouraged today in the midst of your personal struggles, pains and suffering hold onto God and keep serving him in everything you do because in Jesus Name you are HEALED. Remember God loves and cares for you so much that he died for you!

Dear God, we pray that you help us to be patient in our suffering and that there is light at the end of the tunnel with you! We pray that you can use us to help serve those people around us who are experiencing any pain or suffering. In your Holy name we pray, Amen.

Pastor's Column

This morning's service centres on the second candle of the Advent wreathe which we are calling "Peace"

Do you have peace? (perhaps "Christmas peace": peace to those on whom his favour rests -Luke 2:14)? How can we at this time of the year? It is such a tur-

Perhaps we are just confused over what this peace really is.

In the address this morning we shall discover that this peace ("God's peace") is a peace within - not something on the outside: it's a peace that indeed comes from God himself- not something we can create and a peace; which we can give to others - not something we try to hold onto. We'll discover how we can have -(or better put) how we grow in this peace.

Remember, you can talk to me or one of the Pastoral Carers if you feel you need someone to pray with you if you feel that you are lacking this peace in your life.

This morning we are distributing Holy Communion in a slightly different manner. Basically the distributors will remain stationary (at their stations) and the congregation moves - to receive the wafer and then the wine before moving back to their seats. (Some call it "Continuous Communion".) It's how we distributed Salt Factory last week and similar to what we did at our confirmation service on 17th Novem-

Salt Factory tonight Paul Napier will be speaking on "Discipleship".

Also today you are able to take hand-outs for the Christmas play to distribute (letter drop if you like) to the houses around where you live.

Please take half a dozen to a dozen flyers per family and give them out over the next few weeks.

You will notice on the flyers there is a space for you to write your own phone number so the person you give the flyer to can contact you if they need a lift to the play. Feel free to use this opportunity.
