

#### **TWO MINUTES**

#### Praise God through Christ Jesus (God's nature revealed)

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. **Ephesians 1: 3** 

Here Paul praises our heavenly Father because of what God has done for us through our Lord Jesus Christ. This shows God's nature. He spells out "the spiritual blessings" in the following verses (of the second reading). They include: being chosen, being holy and blameless to God, adopted, redeemed, forgiven, having his will revealed... in fact every blessing we could ever have hoped for! We don't see them in their fulfillment now because they are "in the heavenly realms" (One day we shall see them though. In the meantime we have the Holy Spirit "as a deposit".) This shows that God is merciful, generous, compassionate....What strikes me is how essential Christ is in all this, for it is all "in Christ Jesus".

Can't we praise our heavenly Father too? And isn't that why we are gathered this morning? Isn't our worship a great way to start the New Year- in Jesus' name? Doesn't our worship assure us for we too are in Christ Jesus through our Baptism? Let's use our worship this morning — with the Baptism, the songs, confession and absolution, teaching about what God has done, the testimonies about what God has done in certain people's lives, the prayers and blessings all to praise him: our heavenly Father, through the Holy Spirit in Jesus name. Often God shows his nature through a story but here it's through praise.

We praise you, our Triune God. We thank you for all that you have done for us through Jesus Christ our Lord. We adore you in anticipation that you will reveal your nature to us in our worship this morning. Amen.
