TWO MINUTES

Luke 4:1-13

The main thing that strikes me about this passage is that it was not only Jesus that quoted the word of God to prove a point. The devil knows what was written in the Bible. He says, "For it is written: 'He will command his angels concerning you to guard you carefully..." (4:10). The devil uses God's word to get Jesus to go against God's will. The only reason that the devil is not successful is because Jesus' knowledge of God's word and will is deeper than the devil's understanding.

My understanding and knowledge of the Bible, I think, is adequate. However, if the devil came and started quoting the Bible to me I do not think that I would have the knowledge to defeat him. This is a scary thought. It would be nice to think that only the people who believe in one saviour would read and know the Bible. But this is not always the case. There are many people who take passages out of the Bible and use them in a context, with the purpose of proving their point, ignoring God.

We can take comfort in the fact that Jesus does not want us to be harmed or to take a path that does not lead to him. We know that God is ALWAYS with us and will help us whenever we ask. But a sound knowledge of the Bible would be so useful! (not to mention all the ways reading the Bible will benefit our relationship with God ©)

"Lord, help us to grow closer to you through reading and understanding your word. Help us to recognise the times people are using you word to go against your will. Thank you for always being with us and protecting us. Amen."

Pastor's Column

We are taking up the theme of the up-coming GATHERING in worship this morning: **Zone into God**.

Have you ever walked into a group of people and felt completely out of touch with these people, wondering just where they are coming from and what they are on about? Somehow you have to zone into their thinking if you want to part of the group (like entering the tropical or temperate zone). Another way of putting that: you have to tune in your antenna, or try to get it straight (work out how to get the bull's eye) to zone into them. Well isn't it the same with God?...... we'll look at this in the address this morning as we zone into 1 Peter 1:13 "Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming.

Don't forget the details about the GATHERING: Saturday 27th February, 8.30am-12.30pm with a BBQ lunch following at *Wirrimbirra* (Schmocker's place, second entry on the left, up the extension of Grenfell Road, Lot 65): a time of worship, discussion, retreat and Holy Communion. Bring some morning tea to share, a salad to share, donation for BBQ meat and a chair.

We are starting **another group** for people who would like to be confirmed in their faith. Many who are suffering for their faith in Jesus don't ask for the persecution to stop, they simply plead: "Pray for us, and please send Bibles." Next Sunday our congregation will begin: **Bibles for persecuted Christians**, a 21 days program which will focus special attention on our courageous persecuted brothers and sisters in Christ.
