

TWO MINUTES

Luke 13: 31-35 - Jesus' Sorrow for Jerusalem

How many of us have been in a situation where we've had to choose whether we help someone who is in trouble or real danger when it meant going way outside our comfort zone. It might have meant being quite frightened of the outcome either way. If we had stayed to help it could have put us in grave danger and if we didn't stay to help someone it would have put them in a very dangerous situation. It may even have been a life or death situation. Obviously it could have been a really hard to decision to make.

I wonder whether Jesus had these thoughts of doubt and the temptation to 'run' when the Pharisees came to tell Him that Herod wanted to kill him and that He should flee Jerusalem. Jesus knew what His Father's plan was for him but the human part of him could have left Jerusalem and remained safe from Herod's clutches. However Jesus knew that his role on this earth was to eventually die on a cross so that ordinary people like you and I would be saved from certain death and destruction.

I'm so humbled and thankful that Jesus decided not to run from Herod but stayed to die for me that I could be saved and eventually live a life with Him in heaven.

Welcome to our Confirmation service this morning. I love the aspect of confirmation as God confirming the young people in other words God is blessing them/ strengthening them/ giving them encouragement for the next part of their journey; ie. after today. Please pray fro them that they will respond to God's blessing and grow in their faith and love and hope.

The theme for this morning's address is "Chick under the wing" I am using Jesus' comforting imagery of the Gospel reading for today (Luke 13:34: "How often I have longed to gather you as a hen gathers her chicks under her wing). I will put to you that in this position: you are safe and protected, warm and loved and given hope to live again.
