

TWO MINUTES

"So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him. **LUKE 15: 20** (NLT)

This verse to me is the climax of the story Jesus told in today's Gospel reading of the Lost Son, also called the Waiting Father and as mentioned in the sermon this morning, a description of the Prodigal God.

The son was on his way home after coming to his senses and "while he was still a long way off" his father responded. (Actually the son was responding to the father's love in the first place –See verse 17- page 716.) He saw him coming- imagine him sitting on the flat roof of his house looking in the direction his son had gone, longing for him to return. He was "filled with love": his son was more important than anything else in his life, "and compassion": he felt deeply for his son, what he'd gone through and the turmoil he was now going through; "he ran to his son": ignoring convention that an older man doesn't run; he "embraced him": took him to himself; "and kissed him": lavished his affection on him.

This is indeed God's response to me! God is indeed the Prodigal God – the God who recklessly lavishes his love and compassion on me! O the joy of repentance to know that this forgiveness is awaiting me, no matter what I have done and how far away I am from home and my waiting father. Why would I continue to sit in the pig pen?

I hope that you can say this too.

Prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you for this picture of our Heavenly Father you give in this story. May we certainly take it to heart that it may draw us to the Father, through yourself, by means of the Holy Spirit beating in our hearts. Amen.

Pastor's Column

Over these weeks in March we are taking up some of the tough questions that the world puts to us— although I would hasten to add maybe it's God who is putting these questions to us, so as to refine us.

Why these tough questions? you ask. In our program of "Creating Confidence to share our faith" we are taking up the thought that one thing that may make us hesitant to share our faith are the questions and objections that people may have for us or throw at us. By facing some of these questions through the Address in our Worship we may have more confidence to do what God has called on us - to be the evangelist he has given us the gifts with our story, the Gospel message and knowing the Holy Spirit will work through us as we step out in faith.

Next week we shall be looking at the question: "What are we doing for the poor", based on the Gospel reading for the day, in particular John 12:5 "Why wasn't this perfume sold and the money given to the poor? It was worth a year's wages.

This Wednesday in our half hour LENTEN DEVOTION we are looking at Psalm 60. Are you planning to come along?

We are extending our program Bibles for persecuted Christians, which focuses special attention on our courageous persecuted brothers and sisters in Christ, by another week. So it will be next Sunday when we shall be dedicating our boxes in a special Bible offering ceremony. So, continue reading the information in your resource booklet, praying for the persecuted and using the money box. ("A Light in the Dark" prayer resource booklet and a Bible shaped money box are available in the foyer).

It's getting closer to Easter. Please check out the worship opportunities at Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship over Easter. I would like to draw your attention to the Dawn Service. This year it will be at Jon & Jacquie Schutz's (Range Road North) at 6.30am. At that service I am encouraging people to give a short testimony (your story as we have termed it in "Creating Confidence to Share your faith"): how God has touched you in a special way. In the last few weeks I have perceived that there are some wonderful stories around by hearing the "I believe statements" of the confirmees, in talking to people about baptisms and about growing in their faith. Please consider if you would like to share your story and let me know if you would like to do so at the Dawn Service.

What's it all about?.....When people ask me about baptism I reply by suggesting I visit their home where I present what baptism is and we discuss what it means for them. By agreeing to a visit some people may think that they are committed to being baptized or having their children baptized, although there have been cases where people have decided not to go ahead with the baptism after our discussion. We are running this evening to remove that feeling of commitment prior to baptism. It is simply an opportunity where people can get some more information to help them make up their mind whether baptism is for them/their children or not. Please note this evening will go ahead only if people indicate an interest to me about attending.

Logos - Evening Sessions - Starting Sunday 21 March at 8:00pm - 9:30pm

Over the last few weeks we have been running a course on Sunday mornings called Logos. It is all about what Christians believe and why they believe it. It covers those obscure or difficult questions like where did angels and demons come from?, how Jesus can be a man and yet be God?, and who wrote the Bible?

There have been a number of people who have said they would like to come to Logos but can't make Sunday mornings. In response we have decided to start up a second stream of Logos session on Sunday Evenings.

Part 1 is being running during terms 1 and 2 this year on Sunday evenings after the Salt Factory service. It is a 7 week course which asks the question, who is God and what is He like? Topics such as the doctrine of the Trinity, who wrote the Bible, and the nature of good and evil are discussed.
