Pastor's Column

Today is designated in the Church as "Trinity Sunday" or "Whitsunday" and you will notice that the Bible readings for today have reference to God being one, yet disclosing himself in three persons: Father Son and Holy Spirit.

We are continuing our theme of "Grow in faith" through the Bible by having a closer look at the second reading Romans 5:1-5, especially verses 3 and 4 "Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope" and how suffering refines our faith. The theme is "Unexpected growth".

Have you experienced growth in unexpected ways: physically and spiritually? When God is involved we trust that this will lead to our maturity but we wonder why the suffering, why the process, and how do we cooperate with it - if I can put it that way. I am going to use incidents in the Bible to consider these questions today.

I hope this explains something of what you are experiencing in your life and it gives you hope as God fosters that growth *in the most unexpected ways...* even through suffering.

Today we are celebrating *Holy Communion* and holding the second of our *Kids at Heart Time* (where the children leave the congregation for a special time of singing, story telling and plays). Both Holy Communion and Kids at Heart Time were postponed from last week's service because of it being a School Family Service.

During this month I am encouraging you to **give your story about how God has answered your prayers**. So please consider standing up one Sunday and sharing this with the congregation. It may be a dramatic answer or a simple way God moved. Please let me know if something comes to mind so I can slot it into one of our worship service in June.

the Prayer Request box, the Welcome Sheets, joining our Sunday Prayers roster, our prayer chain,

being available to pray after the sermon on a Sunday morning, the call from our AGM to pray for GGLF and

praying (with the Bible Reading plan) as a good spiritual habit.

KIDS AT HEART

Mark 10: 14... "Let the little children come to me"

In the interest of expanding our children's ministry program, the Kids at Heart team now have a special time for our little ones: <u>Kids at Heart time</u>. Goal: To Share the love of Jesus with songs, stories, games and more!

After the children's address and craft activity, the children and helpers move to the GGOSH room for MORE FUN!

Kids at Heart time is normally held every 2nd and 4th Sunday- BUT will be held **today** because last week it was not held due to School Sunday. We aim to finish about 10 minutes after the service- ie during coffee time.

At "Kids at heart time", we use familiar children's bible stories/themes, as a basis for our activities. Last time, we heard the story and made Lion's masks for "Daniel and the Lions Den". It was an opportunity to talk about Daniel's trust and faith in God which surely would have been tested as he spent the night surrounded by hungry Lions! (Even though it meant breaking the king's new law, Daniel obeyed God by praying. He did not let people around him change his mind about doing the right thing.)

Lessons from Daniel's life:

- God wants us to pray—talk to and listen to Him—all the time, not just when we need or want something from Him. Daniel prayed three times a day.
- God wants us to be kind to those who are mean to us.
- God wants us to obey Him even when our friends think we are dumb for doing what He says to do.
- God wants us to use our skills and talents to let others know how good God is.

God keeps us safe when we do what He says.
