TWO MINUTES

Enthusiastic Prayer

As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem. And he sent messengers on ahead, who went into a Samaritan village to get things ready for him; but the people there did not welcome him, because he was heading for Jerusalem. When the disciples James and John saw this, they asked, "Lord, do you want us to call fire down from heaven to destroy them?" But Jesus turned and rebuked them. Then he and his disciples went to another village. **Luke 9: 51-56**

I love the enthusiasm of these "sons of thunder", James and John. They got it wrong and Jesus had to rebuke them. But their faith, their child-likeness, their honesty, their knowledge of the Old Testament, their offence on behalf of Jesus and their defence of Jesus I find most inspiring.

This text (which we'll hear in the Gospel reading this morning) asks us about our prayer life (as we are considering this month our "Growth in faith through prayer"). Are we so enthusiastic when we approach Jesus – in prayer? Sure, on occasion we may get it wrong but Jesus can use that. He teaches us through the Bible, especially about who God is and what his will is for our life, and that gives us enthusiasm.

I encourage you to pray "enthusiastic prayers" and so grow in faith. I talk more about that in the address this morning.

Prayer: Lord, please forgive us when our prayers have been less than enthusiastic. We pray give us life and enthusiasm to our prayers. Thank you for the Holy Spirit who works through our prayers and gives them this enthusiasm. Amen. **Pastor Leon**

Pastor's Column

What do I mean by "enthusiastic prayer"? The Gospel reading for today gives a few examples of people who were very enthusiastic in their approach to Jesus- their prayer. How does Jesus handle that? How can we learn from that? Should our prayer be more enthusiastic?

Remember our ministry of care meetings (of which we have one again this Wednesday) is for anyone who would like support in their care for another person. (These were originally Pastoral Care meetings but now it's the Pastoral Carers who host these meetings to support the other members of the congregations in the care God has provided for us to do.)

During this month as we are considering how we grow in faith- through prayer I am encouraging you to give your story of how God has answered your prayers. So please pray about standing up one Sunday and sharing this with the congregation. It may be a dramatic answer to prayer or a simple way God moved, something that changed your life or changed the moment, something you have shared widely or not at all, recent or in the distant past. As I announced last Sunday, let me know during a song if something comes to mind and we will give you an opportunity to speak straight after that song. (Remember to keep it short.)

Next Sunday we begin the next step of our series: Grow in Faith. We'll be considering **Grow in faith in the community**.

Our ALC student, James Leach will be leading the service the following week. The address for that week is based on Matthew 6:25-34. How do you handle worry?

Don't forget about our **Prayer Vigil** in and for our congregation, in a month's time (31/7/10). Put your name down on the schedule so we can ensure the 24 hours are filled up.
