Pastor's Column

Today we are celebrating Mountain Sunday as part of our Season of Creation. We'll be looking at **Psalm 121** (*I lift up my eyes to the mountains— where does my help come from? My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth – verse 1, 2*) and be considering mountain top experiences in the Bible and in our own lives. We'll look at the term "spiritual mountains" and see what that means for us.

Mountains put us in our place but they also give us freedom. I hope that you gain a higher concept of life and God through a worship today.

Unfortunately the Principals at the two schools in Asaroka with which we are in partnership **Peter Hasu** and **Maiké Keguma** haven't made it to Australia yet. They were planning to arrive last Thursday but it won't be to Tuesday now. We shall introduce them in the worship next Sunday and we shall have a **shared early lunch following worship next Sunday morning. Please plan to stay and greet our two visitors- next week—and if you could please bring a plate of finger food to share.**

Next Sunday we are also concluding this year's Season of Creation with **Sky Sunday**. The morning service will be a Family Service – run by the Kids @ Heart Team. We are celebrating Marcus Waldhuter's Baptism and Holy Communion. We are also planning that the service begins with a procession of children waving prayer flags, that the Worship Centre be adorned with prayer flags as well as a large rainbow painted by the children. The liturgy and readings will be done by the children/families and we will be holding our special morning tea outside, after we follow the procession of children with their prayer flags at the end of the service.

We encourage you as part of the congregation to wear **blue** next Sunday and to bring along a **plate of food** to share for our early lunch following the service.

We have always maintained that everything we do in our Fellowship we do "**in mission**". We see the Season of Creation as one such opportunity to invite your friends that don't normally come to our church.

I spoke in length last Bulletin about an outreach program entitled "**Mainly Music**". Please see last week's Bulletin if you aren't sure what this means. It will be starting on Wednesday 13th October and continuing every Wednesday morning (for the school terms). Thanks to all those who came along to the demo last Tuesday and remember if you want to get involved in the program see our School Chaplain James Ziersch or phone him on 0435008513. The **Steve Grace Concert** is less than 7 weeks away (6th November) and the plans for this are well and truly under way. Over the next weeks you will be hearing a lot more about our Concert as the team ramps up its promotion.
