TWO MINUTES

Mark 1.9-15

As I read this passage on the baptism and temptation of Jesus, I wondered who saw the Holy Spirit descending on Jesus like a dove besides Jesus himself. The Gospel of Mark does not indicate it, but the Gospel of John indicates that John the Baptist also saw the Holy Spirit descending on Jesus and then testified that Jesus was the Son of God.

When Jesus was sent out to the desert by the Spirit, he fasted for 40 days & nights and became very hungry. But still Satan could not tempt him in any way, for the Holy Spirit was with Him.

This same Holy Spirit is with you also, to empower and to lead you in your life. What is the Holy Spirit calling you to? A closer walk with Jesus? Maybe to take some extra time to feed and meditate on His word. Or maybe to get involved with the church, which God loves here at GGLF. Listen to what God is saying to you and obey – you will live a richer life in His presence each day.

Father, refresh me again by your Holy Spirit, so I am able to hear your small voice and be open to your Holy Spirit's leading in my life.

Pastor's Column

A special welcome to **Brett Jaffer**'s family. Brett is finally receiving the gift of Holy Baptism today. (When we had first planned it he came down with chicken pox.) Marty & Marilyn Seidel are Brett's family's support family from our congregation. (If you would like to know more about Support Families please see me.)

What a great day to have a baptism. This morning is a Family service (the first one run by our new Kid's at Heart team) I am looking forward to what the team have come up with to present Jesus' statement "I am the bread of life."

Through these Sundays in Lent we are looking at the 7 "I am statements" of Jesus from John's Gospel. Next week the theme is "I am the light of the world" (from John 8:12 and 9:5)

I am also excited about the course **Everyday Evangelism** which starts this Wednesday. Christiaan from the Ministry Team will be speaking about this course again this morning.

The Vision For Ministry (Leadership team) felt that after such a great **GATHERING** a couple of weeks ago - and the feeling of anticipation that followed - that we shouldn't lose the momentum. So God willing you will have the SWOT analysis and "Vision for 2013" from the Gathering in your pigeon holes by next Sunday. But in preparation for receiving that just a few comments:

Yes, The Gathering is a talk fest – it doesn't have constitutional validity so nothing is decided there. But the opinions of the 20-30 people, who have been coming to the Gathering and who give up a Saturday morning for this are certainly respected. (Talking about numbers, because we've had between 20 and 30 different people there each time, I guess we would have over 60 people who have attended a Gathering.) The Gatherings have always had in mind the vision of our congregation, but each one has taken us one step closer to coming up with a vision for GGLF. The first, which was called a Leaders Retreat had as its thrust "...where God is leading us and what we need to be doing to get there." The second Gathering, we looked at "what God was blessing and how we can take that to the next level" and came up with GGAF, our School and the Youth Ministry. The third Gathering presented the vision of the 7 aspects of our congregation that we value highly: Worship, Pastoral Care, the Fellowship Groups, Ministry, GGAF, Youth, School, Management and we were encouraged to set goals, do it with excellence and step out in faith.

That led to the recent Gathering where we compiled SWOT analysis and a picture of what GGLF could look like in 5 years time. This is to lead to the VFM setting some goals which I imagine could be presented at the congregation's AGM. There have also been a number of suggestions, conclusions and feelings from the Gatherings that have been acted on in one way or another soon after the respected Gathering. The format of the Gathering: worship with a short message, a presentation with a long discussion time, morning tea and a extended time of reflection/prayer, a time of debriefing and Holy Communion, followed by lunch have facilitated responses that could be acted on.

I believe the Gathering is a worthwhile experience in our congregation, which I am sure you would have gathered from being there or just reading my articles about this opportunity we are giving you. So I hope you are looking forward to reading the Report available next week and will read it in a way that you will get the most out of it.


