### **TWO MINUTES**

Hebrews 5: 5 - 10 ( v5 ): "You are my Son; today I have become your Father"

In this passage we read how God acknowledged Jesus as His Son. What a burden to bear, what pressure and what a responsibility to carry through his life on earth! Yet throughout his life, Jesus did not falter or stumble or deny any of his responsibilities, because he submitted or surrendered himself to do God's will – the will as in "Your will be done" which most of us would say daily in the Lord's Prayer and yet, do we realize what we are actually asking? As a son, he knew he had to do as he was told. He had to be **obedient**. Jesus prayed constantly to his Heavenly Father and, we are told that "he was heard because of his reverent submission". Perhaps as a nation, as people of South Australia, as ratepayers of Tea Tree Gully, as members of Golden Grove Lutheran Fellowship and as members of our own families who are so important to us, we should prayerfully submit to our Heavenly Father and seek His will. We will be heard! Jesus' supreme sacrifice on the Cross has guaranteed eternal salvation to those who turn to him and obey him. Where else can we get such a guarantee? Doesn't Our Father know best?
