

## PENTECOST

On Sunday our churches will be decked out in red as a visual reminder of the gift of the Holy Spirit sent by God to the disciples in Jerusalem. The Day of Pentecost is the culmination of the Easter celebration; the risen Christ, having shown himself to his disciples and having ascended, sends the promised gift of the Spirit to the expectant church. The coming of the Spirit gives the church the power and necessary gifts to carry the glad news of the resurrection from Jerusalem to the ends of the earth. The early church often observed Pentecost as a time of Baptism, commemorating the Baptism of three thousand by the Apostles, a kind of spiritual 'first-fruits' of the Christian Church. The Sundays after Pentecost are said to represent the time of the church, a time of growth in the Spirit as the risen Christ is formed in his people.
