#### **TWO MINUTES**

Mark 4: 35-41 Jesus calms the storm

While you may know the story of Jesus calming the storm really well, did you notice one sentence, "There were also other boats with him".

Going back to the beginning of the chapter, Jesus was speaking to the crowd and, because it was so large, he got into the boat and pushing to just offshore began speaking to them in parables. When evening came he asked the disciples to go over to the other side and then fell asleep. The storm arose and they woke Jesus who then rebuked the wind and calmed the waves. Curiously no further mention is made of the "other boats" in the rest of the passage. We know that the disciples were terrified at what they had witnessed, but don't you wonder what the occupants of the "other boats" thought? Jesus asks us to simply "have faith".

Dear Lord, you who are so mighty that even the wind and waves obey you, please help us simply to have faith in you so that we can cope with the storms and troubles of our lives. In your name we pray. Amen


