TWO MINUTES

Mark 5:21-43 and Lam. 3:22-33.

In the first passage we are presented with two main characters. One of them, Jairus, a prominent person, had enjoyed twelve years of pleasure with his only daughter. The other, an unknown woman who had endured twelve years of pain, distress and humiliation. One person faced a sudden emergency and crisis; the other had endured a long chronic illness. When Jairus' daughter was struck down with illness, he went to Jesus for help. The woman also went to Jesus for healing, although doctors had been unable to help her. Jesus responded to their faith in him. The woman was healed immediately. But Jairus' faith was tested when messengers came telling of the child's death. However he believed Jesus' word and soon rejoiced in answered prayer.

Jeremiah, the author of Lamentations, served God faithfully and sacrificially, but was caught up in the devastating fulfilment of his prophecies. He was in Jerusalem when it fell to Nebuchadnezzar's armies.

None of us has the same life experiences and God our Father deals with us accordingly. In the Lamentation reading today, God reminds us that his love comes to us fresh each day and as sure as the sunrise. Whatever our circumstance nothing can separate us from his love and grace.

PRAYER: Lord increase our faith! Whether we are facing a crisis, live with a chronic condition or adverse circumstances overtake us, help us to trust you and experience your grace. May we experience the comfort of your unfailing love and find strength to daily bring you an offering of praise. Amen.


