Pastor's Column

Welcome to our worship today. Today James Leach who is studying at Australian Lutheran College is leading the morning service and presenting the message at both the morning service and at Salt Factory. He is basing his talk on the Gospel reading for today, in particular John 5:24-27 "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. I tell you the truth, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live. For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself. And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man.

I am on holidays but will be back in the office mid week.

As I mentioned last week next Sunday we are holding our Remembrance Sunday. It is an opportunity to remember any loss that we are still grieving. Loss can take many forms: the loss of a loved one through death (in the past we have invited all those people who experienced a funeral of someone in their family in the previous year to this service, but you may be grieving the loss of a friend or associate sometime in the past) or the loss through moving, a loss of health or ability or something prematurely being taken from you or even a death of a pet. Whatever you are missing- grieving over- this service is planned to minister to you. During the service you will be given the chance to light a candle, you will have some quiet time to reflect, to pray and prayer will be offered on your behalf. I plan to preach on "Time to look up" based on a verse from the Gospel reading for the day: Luke 21:28 When these things begin to take place, stand up and lift up your heads because your redemption is drawing near




CHRISTMAS PLAY - VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
