I Cor 12:1

In the early church the apostles witnessed a powerful outpouring of the Holy Spirit with his accompanying gifts for believers. This was something new. There were times when God's Spirit anointed a person for a particular task that God required i.e. to be king or a prophet. But seeing 'ordinary' people filled with the Spirit and displaying miraculous gifts was a sign of God's new order. While there was no dispute that these gifts were from God, there was differing opinions about which ones were more valued and beneficial.

lt's into this situation that Paul talks to the Corinthians about Spiritual gifts. We see that Paul understands that these gifts are a natural part of the church Jesus creates. Before he ascended Jesus gave the church the mandate to make disciples; to teach the gospel and to assist all who desire an encounter with the risen Lord. It is completely normal that where Jesus crucified and raised is preached, there will be a movement of the Holy Spirit with the invitation to receive Spiritual gifts.

We believe that God's provision of Spiritual gifts is just as real today as it was in the first century. And Jesus encourages us to be bold and ask for gifts that will be of service within our community and will be a witness to His authority in the world. May God's Spirit fill us so that we embrace His gifts.

Review of the LCA/NZ Constitution - Phase 1 Guiding Principles for a 21st Century LCA/NZ

A message to all members, bodies and agencies of the Lutheran Church of Australia and New Zealand

On behalf of our General Synod, the General Church Board is conducting a Review of the LCA/NZ Constitution, as we seek to be faithful to Christ, live the gospel and thrive in this 21st century. The board is pleased to invite you to participate in the Review through telling the reviewers what you think needs to change, or alternatively does not need to change, in the LCA/NZ Constitution.

The survey will remain open until 30 April 2020.

Individuals may also complete the survey.

Important notes:

- This Review, and therefore this survey, is only about matters relating directly to the LCA/NZ Constitution. If your responses comment on other issues, the reviewers will be unable to respond to them, but will do their best to refer them on to the relevant persons.
- Individuals will only be able to complete the survey once. If you are the representative of a district, agency, board, committee or congregation AND you also want to complete the survey separately as an individual, you will need to ask another member of the agency, board or congregation etc to complete the survey on that group's behalf.

'Constitutional Review Discussion Starter' paper. This paper intentionally takes an 'arm's length' and critical look at our Church, examining where we may be in relation to the societies in which we minister. The paper also lists a number of key issues for us to consider in this Review and, finally, it lists the substantive questions that you will find when you access the electronic survey. This way you know in advance what the survey questions are. The paper is in part provocative in order to stimulate widespread discussion about this Review.

Please read and reflect on the 'Discussion Starter' paper before completing the survey.

The Louise Flierl Mission Museum was opened in March 1998 in the old St Paul's church building in Hahndorf. The museum has had on display culturally significant artefacts such as masks, shields, bows and arrows, sorcery and magic bundles, flutes, clothing and jewellery, drums, bilums and much more, they have been gathered since 1886 by people who served in Australian Lutheran international mission fields, principally in Papua New Guinea.

The museum has been relocated, under the guidance of project manager Timothy Pietsch, to the eastern wing of the LLL building in Archer Street. North Adelaide.

Friends of Lutheran Archives has been invited to visit the museum and to hear some of the stories associated with it.
